NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF INITIAL STUDY NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE BANNING MDP LINE H, STAGE 1 PROJECT

PROJECT INFORMATION

The Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District proposed project consists of construction, operation and maintenance of an underground storm drain system comprised of approximately 3,700 lineal feet of reinforced concrete pipe ranging in size from 48 inches to 72 inches in diameter and an outlet structure within Smith Creek.

REASON FOR PUBLIC NOTICE

In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the District has conducted an Initial Study for this project which analyzes potential impacts this project may have on the environment. The result of this study shows this project will not significantly impact the environment and a Mitigated Negative Declaration is proposed. This public notice is to solicit comments, questions or concerns about the environmental analysis.
