

Notice of Intent to Adopt a Negative Declaration for the Moreno MDP Line K Project

In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), a draft Initial Study and Negative Declaration (IS/ND) have been prepared by the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) as the Lead Agency for the proposed Moreno MDP Line K Project. Additionally, the Notice of Intent and IS/ND may be accessed at the District office at 1995 Market Street, Riverside California, and at the City of Moreno Valley City Hall at 14177 Frederick Street, Moreno Valley, California.

The proposed project is the acquisition of right of way by the District of the Moreno Master Drainage Plan (MDP) Line K floodplain and adjacent banks to preserve flood conveyance for the existing 100 year flow rate as well as the future Moreno MDP Line K system flow rate. The approximate 36 acres of right of way is located south of Ironwood Avenue, west of Moreno Beach Drive, north of Highway 60 and mostly east of Oliver Street within the city of Moreno Valley.

The proposed project is located within Township 3 South, Range 3 West, Section 3 of the Sunnymead, California 7.5 Minute USGS Quadrangle.

Significant environmental impacts were not identified and the District intends to adopt a Negative Declaration per the requirements of CEQA.
