1.0 This addendum is considered to be part of the RFP. All other terms of the RFP remain unchanged and in effect. This addendum is intended to provide additional information and/or to change requirements in the above referenced RFP. Any information contained herein will be considered part of the RFP and as such will be used in the evaluation of the bid responses. Attention all potential bidders, if you have already submitted your proposal prior to the bid closing date, please review this addendum and re-submit your bid response, should this addendum modify your initial bid response.

3.0 The information in this addendum is primarily the result of written questions submitted by vendors prior to the deadline for questions, November 17, 2009 by 5:00 PM.

4.0 Questions from Bidders:

4.1 There is no mention of ground control survey task in this proposal. Is it a part of this RFP? And if not, how do you plan to obtain it?

Answer: Ground cover will not be required. Please refer to the RFP, Scope of Service.

4.2 If the acquisition is specified with a DMC (digital camera) does the RFCDD desire “hard copy” photos? As an alternative, may we provide digital thumbnail images? This has been acceptable solution for other similar projects we have successfully delivered.

Answer: As specified in the RFP, “One set of hard copy color prints plotted on semi-gloss 10 mil media. The dimension of the larger side of the image is to measure 9 inches.”

4.3 In the past, has the project been collected with a digital camera?

Answer: No.

4.4 [Bidder] owns both DMC and Vexcel sensor types; as such, [Bidder] wanted to know if the Vexcel could be proposed for this project.

Answer: No, use the DMC as specified in the RFP.

4.5 Will there be orthoimagery, or are the deliverables only hard copy photos along with the 300 dpi digital equivalents?

Answer: Orthoimagery will not be required. Please refer to the RFP for deliverables.

4.6 Can a firm propose with only the digital camera option, or is it necessary to provide pricing for both film and digital?

Answer: Yes, a firm may submit a proposal for only the digital camera option.

4.7 Is the ground survey component required to control the orthophotography being furnished by Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District?

Answer: Refer to answers for Questions 1 and 5.

4.8 As a primary aerial data acquisition company with emphasis in analog photography, must we provide costing for the digital acquisition? If not, how exactly do we respond to the Cost Proposal Sheet (Exhibit A), sections (E), (F) and the RFP Total?

Answer: If you only want to provide a proposal for the analog portion that would be fine. Leave sections E and F blank.

4.9 Regarding the electronic index sheets, we have been unable to analyze the example of a previous digital index sheet. Can Attachment I be emailed to our firm or made available via the web? Specifically, what is the photo scale of the index sheets?

Answer: The .jpg and .tif files are too large to e-mail we could send to Bidder's FTP site. The index sheets are not of any specific scale, however, the final dimension of the hard copy sheet is 20" x 24".

4.10 Our firm has many examples of large area acquisitions dating back to 2007 that would correlate with this RFP. Will any past performance beyond the last year be assessed in the evaluation process?

Answer: To meet the prerequisite for Section G, Bidders must submit (3) references within the last year (refer to Section G for complete details). If the Bidder chooses, additional references from previous years of work may be included with a maximum of (6) references. Additional references beyond the original (3) must be similar to the scope of service in Appendix A.
