SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING DATE FOR
HOMELAND MASTER DRAINAGE PLAN (REVISION NO. 1)
ROMOLAND MASTER DRAINAGE PLAN (REVISION NO. 1)
AND GIVING NOTICE OF INTENT
IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 18 OF THE DISTRICT ACT
AND THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA)

WHEREAS, this Board intends to undertake two projects in Riverside County, within a portion of the city of Perris and within the unincorporated communities of Homeland and Romoland, California, designated as Homeland Master Drainage Plan (Revision No. 1), and Romoland Master Drainage Plan (Revision No. 1); and

WHEREAS, the proposed projects are bounded generally by the Lakeview Mountains toward the north and east, Rouse Road and Double Butte Mountains toward the south, and the San Jacinto River channel toward the west; and

WHEREAS, the proposed projects consist of the construction, operation, and maintenance of two master planned drainage systems comprised of open channels, underground storm drains and detention basins; and

WHEREAS, reference is made to the engineering estimate of the cost of the proposed projects, contained in the reports entitled "Homeland Master Drainage Plan (Revision No. 1)" and "Romoland Master Drainage Plan (Revision No. 1)" on file with the Clerk of this Board; and

WHEREAS, reference is made to two maps dated August 2005, bearing the name and showing the general location and typical section of the proposed projects which are also on file with the Clerk of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager-Chief Engineer of the District has found that the proposed projects will have a significant effect on the environment and has prepared a Final Environmental Impact Report which will not become final until certified by this Board; and

WHEREAS, any person wishing to comment on the proposed projects or the Final Environmental Impact Report may do so in writing between the date of this notice and the public hearing, or may appear and be heard at the time and place noted below; and

WHEREAS, in a subsequent legal challenge any person may be limited to raising only those issues he, she or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written comments delivered before or at the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, prior to making a decision on the proposed projects or the Final Environmental Impact Report, this Board will consider all written and oral comments; and

WHEREAS, the above-listed documents can be inspected at the District office, 1995 Market Street, Riverside, California 92501 and written comments will be received at the above address; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District in regular session assembled on December 20, 2005 that:

- 1. A public hearing concerning the proposed projects and the Final Environmental Impact Report will be held at 1:30 p.m. on January 24, 2006, at the meeting room of this Board, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California, at which time all public comments shall be heard.
- 2. A copy of this resolution and copies of the above-listed documents shall be posted at least 21 days before said hearing at Perris Branch Public Library, 163 E. San Jacinto Avenue, Perris, CA 92570
- 3. A copy of this resolution shall be posted at least 21 days before said hearing at the Riverside County Clerk and Recorder's Office, 2724 Gateway Drive, Riverside, California 92507.

1	4. The Clerk of this Board is directed to cause a copy of this resolution to be
2	published twice, once at least 21 days before said hearing, and once 7 days following the initial
3	publication, in a newspaper of general circulation in accordance with Section 18 of the District
4	Act and CEQA.
