
Landscape improvements for the District headquarters - December 2007 update


RCB and Sons, Inc. of Riverside has developed and delivered the base site plan for the District landscape upgrades. Shown here are the "first-cut" construction and planting plans (2 sheets each). These ideas are very conceptual and will be further refined as staff works with the landscape architect.

Construction Plan

The construction plan will include upgrades to improve aesthetics, and to provide a driveway approach and parking access that easily identifies the Building 1A front lobby entrance, especially for visitors and persons conducting business with the District. Key aspects of the construction plan are:

- a preliminary footprint of the pedestrian walking path around the site perimeter.
- amenities such as a trellis, decorative fountain, benches, gazebo, tables and drinking fountains in the front lawn area adjacent to Building 1.
- a redesign of the front driveway entrance and parking lot, and water quality treatment features such as porous pavement in the parking area between Building 1A and the maintenance trailer. These improvements will undergo design generally from January to April 2008 and are not currently shown on the draft landscape plan sheets. The driveway entrance modification will likely involve replacing the current median and trees.
- a fence or wall along the Market Street border in the location of the present the chainlink fence.




Market. Street AREA After Color JS 2 JA 60 Freeway



Planting Plan

The planting plan theme involves using California-native plant species and minimizing irrigation needs. The types of plants shown on the plan sheets are examples to demonstrate the variations that are possible. The actual plants and combinations will be selected during early 2008 as the plan is refined. The overall theme will include:

- planting drought-resistant trees and shrubs, particularly in the south corner (front gate, right side as you exit the District) lawn area. This area may also include improved turf to infiltrate parking lot runoff from the site.
- positioning trees to provide shade.
- "flow-through" planters (not shown) near atrium areas in the center, south side of Building 1A to receive roof run-off via a downspout.


