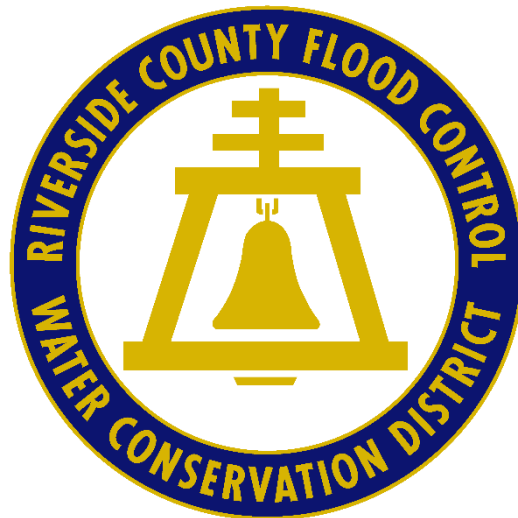

#### **4.0 QUESTIONS FOR CLARIFICATION IN REFERENCE TO THE RFQ.**

**1. For the interview process of Phase 1 (Page 8, Section 3.1 of the RFP), does the District want 1 interview total per division, or 1 interview per individual? (i.e., 1 interview total with all 4 interviewees at the same time for the Design & Construction division, or 4 individual interviews total for the Design & Construction division)**

**Response:** *The interview process for Phase 1 should include at least one interview per Division. The Selected Consult shall conduct as many interviews as required to ensure a full understanding of each Division's needs, work products, current workflows and tools, and interoperation with other Divisions.*

**2. The RFP states that all pages of our response should be 8.5" x 11", however we have a chart that we would like to include that fits on an 11" x 17" page. Would we be able to do so, and if so, would this count as 1 or 2 pages?**

**Response:** *Only Charts and Tables will be allowed on 11" x 17" pages and will count as 1 page.*
